NORFOLK AIR JOINS INTERNATIONAL LINE-UP

NORFOLK Air is the second international carrier to announce services into Gold Coast Airport in as many days, following on from the announcement of Jetstar's Gold Coast-Osaka service last week.

The new service, commencing October 2nd this year, will use a Boeing 737-300 aircraft which offers both Economy and Premium Economy seating.

Gold Coast Airport Chief Operating Officer Paul Donovan said the addition of Norfolk Air capped of a successful week for the airport.

"We're excited to welcome Norfolk Air to our current carrier mix, with Gold Coasters now having access to an affordable international destination offering a vast range of activities.

"The addition is great news for our outbound market and is further testament that the Gold Coast is an attractive prospect for airlines in both an inbound and outbound sense," Mr Donovan said.

Norfolk Air will take its place alongside current international carriers Pacific Blue, Air New Zealand, AirAsia X and Jetstar (commencing October).

There are currently 18 international flights out of Gold Coast Airport per week.
