### QUEENSLAND AIRPORTS GROUP SUSTAINS PASSENGER NUMBERS

Queensland Airports Limited (QAL) has today released the passenger movement figures for its three airports - Townsville, Mount Isa and Gold Coast for the month of May 2008.

Passenger movements recorded through the three airports are summarised below:

Gold Coast	361,282	increase of 25 per cent over May 2007
Townsville	127,323	increase of 6.1 per cent over May 2007
Mount Isa	17,535	increase of 10 per cent over May 2007

“In light of the increasing concerns over fuel costs, this has been a solid performance by our airline partners and the destinations serviced by our airports,” said Dennis Chant, Managing Director of Queensland Airports.

“We are acutely aware of the pressures fuel costs are placing on the air transport industry and the economy as a whole so we continue to work closely with our airline partners and our communities to sustain the current level of services,” he said.
